Findings: We surveyed this uncataloged stream using a backpack electrofisher, baited minnow traps, and GPS. We captured juvenile coho salmon and cutthroat trout. The tributary stream flows through a 1 ft wide culvert with a slight perch, and into a fairly undefined channel dominated by fine organic sediment (Table 1; Figures 1–3).




Figure 4.—114-34-10100 tributary 2 addition map.

Recommendations: Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog for rearing coho salmon (Figure 4).
