**Findings:** We surveyed this uncataloged stream using baited minnow traps and GPS and captured juvenile coho salmon. The tributary stream flows through a 3 ft wide culvert and proceeds down a narrow channel dominated by sand and small gravel sediment (Table 1; Figures 1, 2).

**Recommendations:** Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog for rearing coho salmon (Figure 3).
