


Figure 1.–Barrier falls at waypoint 121.

Findings: We surveyed this cataloged stream up to a FRPA barrier at waypoint 121 (Table 1; Figure 1). The stream is forested, wide, and low gradient up to the falls. We observed pink salmon spawning just downstream of the falls.




Figure 2.—109-42-10090 deletion map.

Recommendations: In the anadromous waters catalog, delete Stream No. 112-42-10160-2021-3003 upstream of the barrier near waypoint 121 to the road where the barrier was previously marked (Figure 2). Add spawning pink salmon to the species and lifestage present.
