## 113-51-10040-2005 Tributary 1

**Findings:** We surveyed this uncataloged stream using baited minnow traps and GPS and captured juvenile coho salmon, Dolly Varden, and cutthroat trout. This stream parallels a beaver pond complex to the north (Table 1; Figures 1–3). A pile of tires was found at waypoint 543 (Figure 4).

**Recommendations:** Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog up to waypoint 541 for rearing coho salmon (Figure 5).
