Datasheet: A backpack electrofishing survey was conducted in this tributary on 8/15/2024. This stretch of stream is an upper fork of waterbody 247-20-10010-2087. In total 2 juvenile coho, 4 dolly varden, and 5 sculpin were captured. Coho parr were IDed, measured, photographed, and released. No apparent fish passage barriers were observed between the current listing and this survey stretch.
