

Flat Lake – Wild



The primary access to Flat Lake is by boat from Big Lake, access for Big Lake located at Big Lake South State Wayside, accessed from Mile 52.3 Parks Hwy., west on Big Lake Rd. 3.6 miles to roundabout, follow South Big Lake Rd. 1.7 miles to Big Lake South Wayside. Or: Continue on South Big Lake Rd. 7.7 miles which turns into West Susitna Pkwy., to Purinton Rd., right on Purinton Rd. 1.7 miles to canal between Mirror and Flat Lakes.
