**EXPLANATION:** This emergency order rescinds Emergency Order number 1-KS-F-11-13. Emergency Order No. 1-KS-F-11-13 closed the salt water area around the mouth of Pullen Creek in Taiya Inlet to king salmon fishing to protect king salmon needed for broodstock. The brood stock goal for king salmon returning to Pullen Creek has been met and the saltwater area closure is no longer needed. Effective 12:01 a.m., Tuesday, August 6, 2013, all salt water in Taiya Inlet is open to king salmon fishing under the regional regulations established under Emergency Order No. 1-KS-R-02-13.

**REGULATION:** Emergency Order No. 1-KS-F-11-13 is rescinded.

**JUSTIFICATION:** King salmon have returned to Pullen Creek in sufficient numbers to meet broodstock needs, and broodstock goals have been met.

**PREVIOUS EMERGENCY ORDERS AFFECTED:** Emergency Order No. 1-RS-F-11-13, issued June 20, 2013, closed the saltwater area off the mouth of Pullen Creek to king salmon fishing to allow king salmon to enter the stream, for broodstock needs, from 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, June 26 through Sunday, August 25, 2013.

Emergency Order No. 1-KS-R-02-13, issued on April 4, 2013, remains in effect.
