EXPLANATION:

This emergency order rescinds emergency order 01-KS-C-19-14 issued August 1, 2014, and removes the prohibition of sport fishing within Blind Slough near Petersburg. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means for the fresh waters of the Southeast Alaska Area. 5 AAC 47.023(h)(1) and (2) remain in effect.

REGULATION:

Emergency order 01-KS-C-19-14 is rescinded.

Emergency order 01-KS-C-19-14 was issued to protect king salmon broodstock returning to Crystal Lake Hatchery. King salmon broodstock is currently being collected at Crystal Lake Hatchery. There is no longer a need to prohibit sport fishing in Blind Slough.
