### EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the saltwater area of Bear Cove to sport fishing to protect coho salmon needed for broodstock at Medveije Hatchery.

### **REGULATION:**

The provisions of 5 AAC 47.021 Special provisions for season, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, and methods and means for the saltwaters of the Southeast Alaska Area (g)(3) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions become effective from 12:01 a.m. Thursday, August 13 through 11:59 p.m. Thursday, December 31, 2015:

# 5 AAC 47.021. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, and methods and means for the salt waters of the Southeast Alaska Area.

- (g) In the Sitka vicinity:
  - (3) the waters of Bear Cove East of a line from a point on the Baranof Island shoreline at 57°00.63' N. latitude, 135°09.80' W. longitude to 57°01.07' N. latitude, 135°09.93' W. longitude are closed to sport fishing;

## JUSTIFICATION:

Coho salmon returning to Medvejie Hatchery are not expected to meet broodstock goals in 2015. Based on anticipated increases in coho production, and projected harvest and marine survival rates, only 960 of the 2,720 coho salmon needed for broodstock are expected to return to the hatchery. This closure is necessary to provide sufficient numbers of coho salmon to meet broodstock needs.
