EXPLANATION:

This emergency order increases the bag and possession limit in the Buskin River drainage for sockeye salmon, 20 inches or greater in length, from two per day to five per day.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 64.022. Waters; seasons; bag, possession, annual, and size limits; and special provisions for the Kodiak Area. (b)(11) are added by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective from 12:01 a.m., Thursday, June 9, through 11:59 p.m. Saturday, December 31, 2016:

5 AAC 64.022 Waters; seasons; bag, possession, annual, and size limits; and special provisions for the Kodiak Area.

(b)(11) in the Buskin River drainage, the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon, 20 inches or greater in length, is five fish;

JUSTIFICATION:

The escapement goal for sockeye salmon into the Buskin River drainage is 5,000 to 8,000 fish. As of June 7, the weir count was 3,317 sockeye salmon. Based on historical run timing, the spawning escapement is projected to exceed the upper end of the escapement goal for this stock. To provide additional sport fish harvest opportunity as provided for in 5 AAC 75.003 (2)(A), the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon, 20 inches or greater in length, in the Buskin River drainage is increased to five fish.
