EXPLANATION:

This emergency rescinds Emergency Order 2-RS-4-27-16 and opens the Pasagshak River drainage to sport fishing for sockeye salmon beginning 12:01 a.m. Thursday, July 14, 2016.

Emergency Order No. 2-RS-4-27-16 is rescinded.

JUSTIFICATION:

The escapement goal for sockeye salmon into the Pasagshak River drainage is 3,000 fish. As of July 13, the weir count was 3,084 sockeye salmon and the escapement goal has been achieved. Therefore, the closure to the sport fishery is no longer necessary.
