EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the saltwater area of Bear Cove to sport fishing to protect king salmon needed for broodstock at Medvejie Hatchery.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 47.021.(g)(3) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions become effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, August 4 through 11:59 p.m. Thursday, August 31, 2017:

5 AAC 47.021. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, and methods and means for the salt waters of the Southeast Alaska Area.

(g) In the Sitka vicinity:

(3) all waters of Bear Cove East of a line from a point on the Baranof Island shoreline at 57°00.63' N. latitude, 135°09.80' W. longitude to a point on the Baranof shoreline at 57°01.07' N. latitude, 135°09.93' W. longitude are closed to sport fishing;

JUSTIFICATION:

King salmon returning to Medvejie Hatchery are not expected to meet broodstock goals in 2017. To date, approximately 2,000 king salmon have been collected for broodstock, an additional 1,000 are needed. This closure is necessary to provide sufficient numbers of king salmon to meet broodstock needs.
