### **EXPLANATION:**

This emergency order increases the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon, from five per day to ten per day, in all waters of the Wood River drainage. The limit for other salmon, except king and sockeye salmon, remains at five per day, five in possession. These limits are in combination with the more liberal limit for sockeye salmon.

## **REGULATION:**

The provisions of 5 AAC 67.022 (h) (5) is added by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective beginning 12:01 a.m. Friday, July 7, 2017, through 11:59 p.m. Sunday, December 31, 2017:

5AAC 67.022 Special provisions for the seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means in the Bristol Bay area.

(h) In the Wood River drainage, the following special provisions apply:

(5) the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon is ten fish; the bag and possession limit for other salmon, other than king salmon, is five fish; the limit for other salmon is in combination with the limit for sockeye salmon;

### JUSTIFICATION:

The escapement of sockeye salmon on the Wood River has exceeded the upper end of the sustainable escapement goal of 1,800,000. Through July 5, 2017, over 1.8 million sockeye salmon have been counted at the Wood River tower. As provided by 5 AAC 75.003 (2) (A), the department has emergency order authority to increase sport fish bag and possession limits when the total escapement is projected to exceed the escapement goal and the total harvest under the increased bag and possession limit will not reduce the escapement below the goal range. Therefore, it is warranted to increase the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon in the Wood River sport fishery.
