EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the saltwater area of Bear Cove to sport fishing to protect king salmon needed for broodstock at Medvejie Hatchery.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 47.021.(g)(3) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions become effective 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, June 20 through 11:59 p.m. Tuesday, July 31, 2018:

5 AAC 47.021. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, and methods and means for the salt waters of the Southeast Alaska Area.

(g) In the Sitka vicinity:

- (3) all waters of Bear Cove East of a line from a point on the Baranof Island shoreline at 57°00.63' N. latitude, 135°09.80' W. longitude to a point on the Baranof shoreline at 57°01.07' N. latitude, 135°09.93' W. longitude are closed to sport fishing;

JUSTIFICATION:

King salmon returning to Medvejie Hatchery are not expected to meet broodstock goals in 2018. Only 6% (n=768) of the Medvejie hatchery king salmon forecast (12,747) has been realized to date. No fish are currently being held for broodstock and cost recovery has only harvested 14 fish. This closure is necessary to provide sufficient numbers of king salmon to meet broodstock needs.
