EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the Pasagshak River drainage to sport fishing for sockeye salmon.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 64.022. Waters; seasons; bag, possession, annual, and size limits; and special provisions for the Kodiak Area. (b)(14) are added by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective from 12:01 a.m. Thursday, July 12 through 11:59 p.m. Monday, December 31, 2018:

5 AAC 64.022. Waters; seasons; bag, possession, annual, and size limits; and special provisions for the Kodiak Area.

(b)(14) the Pasagshak River drainage is closed to sport fishing for sockeye salmon;

JUSTIFICATION:

The escapement goal for sockeye salmon into the Pasagshak River drainage is a lower bound Sustainable Escapement Goal of 3,000 fish. As of July 9, 2018, the weir count was 221 sockeye salmon. Based on historical run timing, about 30% of the run has occurred and the run is projected to fall below the escapement goal. Therefore, it is warranted to close the sockeye salmon sport fishery in an effort to achieve the escapement goal.
