EXPLANATION:

This emergency order rescinds Emergency Order No. 2-RS-5-32-18, issued July 10, 2018. Regulatory provisions for Kvichak River/Lake Iliamna drainage sockeye salmon revert to those embodied under 5 AAC 67.020(2). Effectively, this emergency order restores the bag and possession limit for sockeye salmon in the Kvichak River/Lake Iliamna drainage from two fish to five fish and reopens the four areas closed to sport fishing for sockeye salmon by Emergency Order No. 2-RS-5-32-18. These provisions are effective beginning at 12:01 a.m. Saturday, July 14, 2018.

REGULATION:

Emergency Order 2-RS-5-32-18 is rescinded.

JUSTIFICATION:

Through 6:00 a.m. July 13, 2018, an estimated 1,513,848 sockeye salmon have passed the tower near Igiugig. ADF&G is now able to project that the escapement of sockeye salmon will likely exceed 2.0 million fish; therefore, the reduction of the bag and possession limit and closed areas in place for the sport fishery are no longer warranted.
