EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes Kimberly Lake and Polaris Lake in the Fairbanks area to sport fishing.

REGULATION:

Under the authority of 16.05.060(a) the provisions of 5 AAC 74.010(c)(33) are added by this emergency order. Under this emergency order the following provisions become effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, April 5, 2019:

5 AAC 74.010. Seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means for the Tanana River Area.

(c)(33) notwithstanding the provisions of this section, Kimberly Lake and Polaris Lake are closed to sport fishing.

JUSTIFICATION:

Surface waters in Kimberly and Polaris Lakes have tested to exceed EPA and DEC actions levels for PFAS. As a precautionary measure, Kimberly Lake and Polaris Lake are closed to sport fishing.
