# **EXPLANATION:**

This emergency order closes dipnetting in the vicinity of Anderson Creek, a small tributary of the lower Susitna River. Dipnetting is not allowed in Anderson Creek and between markers located 300 feet downstream and 50 feet upstream of the mouth of Anderson Creek.

# **REGULATION:**

The provisions of 5 AAC 77.540 (h)(2) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective 6:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 15 through 11:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 29, 2020:

# 5 AAC 77.540. Upper Cook Inlet Personal Use Salmon Fishery Management Plan.

(h) Salmon may be taken by dip net in the Susitna River, only as follows:

(2) between ADF&G regulatory markers located approximately one mile downstream from Susitna Station downstream to ADF&G regulatory markers located near the northern tip of Bell Island/Alexander Creek cutoff, excluding the waters of Anderson Creek and between markers located approximately 300 feet downstream and 50 feet upstream of the mouth of Anderson Creek is closed to dipnetting;

Anderson Creek supports a small stock of coho salmon that would be susceptible to overharvest if allowed to be targeted in the Susitna River personal use dip net fishery.
