### **EXPLANATION:**

This emergency order increases the bag and possession limit for coho salmon, 16 inches or greater in length, to six fish in the Ship Creek drainage from its mouth upstream to a cable 100 feet downstream of the Chugach Power Plant Dam.

### **REGULATION:**

The provisions of 5 AAC 59.122 (14)(B) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective from 12:01 a.m. Thursday, August 20 through 11:59 p.m. Thursday, December 31, 2020:

# 5 AAC 59.122. Special provisions for the seasons, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, and methods and means for the Anchorage Bowl Drainages Area.

(14) in the Ship Creek drainage,

(B) the bag and possession limit for coho salmon 16 inches or greater in length is six fish; the bag and possession limit for other salmon, other than king salmon 16 inches or greater in length, is three fish;

### **JUSTIFICATION:**

As of August 18, 2020, a total of 492 coho salmon have been collected at the William Jack Hernandez Sport Fish Hatchery for brood stock. Another 994 coho salmon were counted by foot survey immediately downstream of the hatchery. It is anticipated that the hatchery will meet the coho salmon brood stock goal and there is an adequate number of fish to spawn naturally in Ship Creek. Therefore, it is warranted to increase the coho salmon bag and possession limit in the Ship Creek fishery to provide additional opportunity to harvest surplus fish.
