EXPLANATION:

This emergency order allows the use of bait and eliminates the size limit for trout in Swan Lake (Sitka) to increase harvest opportunity for stocked rainbow trout during the Junior Trout Derby on Saturday, June 12, 2021.

REGULATION:

Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective from 9:00 a.m. through 11:59 p.m. Saturday, June 12, 2021:

- 5 AAC 47.023. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, and methods and means for the fresh waters of the Southeast Alaska Area.
- (g) In the Sitka vicinity:
 - (11) in Swan Lake
 - (A) cutthroat /rainbow trout (in combination): bag and possession limit of 2 fish; no size limit;
 - (B) the use of bait is allowed.

JUSTIFICATION:

Regionwide trout regulations apply in Swan Lake near Sitka. Those regulations include a bag and possession limit for cutthroat/rainbow trout (in combination) of 2 fish; minimum size of 11 inches and maximum size of 22 inches. The use of bait is allowed only September 15 – November 15

The Alaska Board of Fisheries adopted 5 AAC 47.045. Cutthroat and Rainbow Trout Management Plan to provide additional harvest opportunities for trout in fresh waters near Southeast Alaska communities

that fit specific criteria. Under the plan, the department may open, by emergency order, a season and designate one freshwater body near a community to allow the use of bait, eliminate the minimum size limit for trout, and establish a bag and possession limit of two fish if that community does not have nearby freshwater bodies where anglers can fish for trout with bait throughout the year. Sitka fits that definition. The plan also requires that the freshwater body must be close to a community that has good road, trail, or boat access to the freshwater body; and the freshwater body must be landlocked or otherwise inaccessible to sea-run trout. Swan Lake meets those criteria.

Since 1985, the department has annually stocked up to 300 rainbow trout in Swan Lake to provide additional freshwater fishing opportunity in Sitka. This year, the lake was stocked on May 24 with 300 rainbow trout measuring from 6 to 12 inches. The Sitka Rotary club conducts an annual Junior Trout Derby to introduce young anglers to sport fishing. This emergency order will supersede the regulatory prohibition of bait and size limits during the derby to allow young anglers additional opportunity to catch these stocked fish.
