EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the saltwater area of Deep Inlet to sport fishing for coho salmon to protect broodstock needed for Medvejie Hatchery.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 47.021.(g)(11) are added by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, September 22 through 11:59 p.m. Friday, December 31, 2021:

5 AAC 47.021. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, and methods and means for the salt waters of the Southeast Alaska Area.

(g) In the Sitka vicinity:

(11) in Deep Inlet, described as those waters south of a line at 56°59.342'N. lat., 135°18.541'W. long. and 56° 59.07'N. lat., 135°18.555'W. long., sport fishing for coho salmon is closed. Coho salmon may not be possessed or retained; all coho salmon caught may not be removed from the water and must be released immediately.

JUSTIFICATION:

Coho salmon returning to Medvejie Hatchery and Deep Inlet are not expected to meet broodstock goals in 2021 due to expected harvest and the rate of marine survival. To date, no coho salmon have been taken for broodstock and less than 900 coho salmon have returned to Medvejie and Deep Inlet combined. Three thousand (3,000) coho salmon are needed for

broodstock. This closure is necessary to provide sufficient numbers of coho salmon to meet broodstock needs.
