EXPLANATION:

This emergency order opens the Russian River Sanctuary Area to sport fishing for sockeye salmon.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 57.122. (10)(A) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective 12:01 a.m. Thursday, June 24 through 11:59 p.m. Wednesday, July 14, 2021.

- 5 AAC 57.122. Special provisions for the seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means for the Middle Section of the Kenai River Drainage Area.
 - (10) the following waters of the Middle Section are open to sport fishing, only as follows:

 (A) from June 24 through April 30, the Russian River sanctuary area, as defined in subparagraph (4)(D) of this section, is open to sport fishing, except sockeye salmon may be taken only from June 24 through July 14;

JUSTIFICATION:

Through Monday, June 21, 2021, approximately 11,047 sockeye salmon have passed the Russian River weir. ADF&G staff conducted a stream survey on June 21 and estimated 3,500 fish are in the Russian River Sanctuary Area. ADF&G estimates that the early-run Russian River sockeye salmon biological escapement goal of 22,000-42,000 sockeye salmon will be met. Based on this information it is appropriate to liberalize the fishery by allowing anglers the opportunity to harvest sockeye salmon in the Russian River Sanctuary Area.
