EXPLANATION:

This emergency order extends the season open for personal use sockeye salmon fishing in China Poot Creek through Sunday, August 15, 2021.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 77.545. (a) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order the following provisions are effective 12:01 a.m. Sunday, August 8 through 11:59 p.m. Sunday, August 15, 2021:

5 AAC 77.545. Kachemak Bay Personal Use Dip Net Fishery Management Plan.

(a) In China Poot Creek, upstream from ADF&G regulatory markers, sockeye salmon may be taken by dipnet from July 1 through August 15, with a bag and possession limit of six fish. King, pink, chum, and coho salmon may not be retained or possessed. All king, pink, chum, and coho salmon caught must be released immediately and returned to the water unharmed.

JUSTIFICATION:

Sockeye salmon have been stocked in Leisure Lake at the headwaters of China Poot Creek since 1976 with the intention of supplementing commercial catches in Kachemak Bay. Sockeye salmon that escape the commercial fishery and reach China Poot Creek are stopped from reaching Leisure Lake by the barrier falls in the creek and are available for harvest by dipnetters in the fresh waters of the creek.

On August 3, 2021, a stream survey was conducted in China Poot creek and approximately 300 sockeye salmon were counted. There were very few pink salmon present. In order to maximize harvest opportunity of stocked sockeye salmon in this terminal fishery, while minimally impacting wild pink salmon, it is justified to extend the season of the personal use fishery through August 15.
