EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the Buskin River drainage to sport fishing for sockeye salmon.

REGULATION:


The provisions of 5 AAC 64.022. (b)(14) are added by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective 12:01 a.m. Saturday, June 11 through 11:59 p.m. Saturday, December 31, 2022:

5 AAC 64.022. Waters; seasons; bag, possession, annual, and size limits; and special provisions for the Kodiak Area.

(b)(14) the Buskin River drainage is closed to sport fishing for sockeye salmon; sockeye salmon caught incidentally may not be removed from the water and must be released immediately.

JUSTIFICATION:

The biological escapement goal (BEG) for sockeye salmon in the Buskin River drainage is 5,000 to 8,000 fish. Through June 8, 2022, the weir count was 769 sockeye salmon, which is much lower than the historical average for Buskin River sockeye salmon through this date. Based on historical run timing about 22% of the run has occurred and the run is projected to fall below the escapement goal. Therefore, it is warranted to close the sockeye salmon sport fishery in an effort to achieve the escapement goal.
