EXPLANATION:

This emergency order increases the bag and possession limit for coho salmon, 16 inches or greater in length, in the Ship Creek drainage from its mouth upstream to a cable 100 feet downstream of the Chugach Power Plant Dam, to six fish.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 59.122. (a)(14)(B) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, August 17 through 11:59 p.m. Saturday, December 31, 2022:

5 AAC 59.122. Special provisions for the seasons, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, and methods and means for the Anchorage Bowl Drainages Area.

(14) in the Ship Creek drainage,

(B) the bag and possession limit for salmon other than king salmon, 16 inches or greater in length is six fish;

JUSTIFICATION:

As of August 12, 2022 a total of 1,058 coho salmon have been collected at the William Jack Hernandez Sport Fish Hatchery for broodstock. An additional 600 coho salmon were counted by foot survey immediately below the hatchery, in poor survey conditions. It is anticipated that the hatchery will meet the coho salmon broodstock goal and there is an adequate number of fish to spawn naturally in Ship Creek. Therefore, it is warranted to increase the coho salmon bag and possession limit in the Ship Creek fishery to provide additional sport fish harvest opportunity of surplus hatchery fish.
