EXPLANATION:

This emergency order rescinds Emergency Order 1-KS-E-21-25, issued June 26, 2025, which closed an area near Macaulay Hatchery to snagging and king salmon fishing. The hatchery has now met their 2025 broodstock goals for king salmon and this closure is no longer warranted. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, annual, and size limits, previously established for the hatchery terminal area by Emergency Order 1-KS-E-14-25 remain in effect. Snagging continues to be prohibited within 150 yards of the Channel Wayside fishing dock as described in 5 AAC 47.021(d)(5).

Emergency Order 1-KS-E-21-25 was issued to protect king salmon broodstock returning to Macaulay Hatchery. King salmon broodstock collection goals have now been met for 2025. There is no longer a need to prohibit snagging and king salmon fishing in this area near Macaulay Hatchery.

PREVIOUS EMERGENCY ORDERS AFFECTED:

Emergency Order 1-KS-E-21-25 is rescinded.

Emergency Order 1-KS-E-14-25 established bag and possession limits, size limits and removed the nonresident annual limit for king salmon in the vicinity of Macaulay Hatchery and are not affected by this emergency order.
