

## Federal Register Notice Harmful Algal Blooms and Hypoxia Events National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) is seeking public comments to "... inform the development of agency policy for determining HAB and hypoxia events of national significance in marine and coastal waters ... NOAA may make this determination on its own initiative or upon the request of the Governor of an affected state. Following an event of national significance determination, NOAA is further authorized to make sums available to the affected state or local government for the purposes of assessing and mitigating the detrimental environmental, economic, subsistence use, and public health effects of the event of national significance. Funds would be subject to the availability of appropriations ... NOAA will subsequently issue, in the Federal Register, notice of availability of the draft policy and provide an opportunity for formal public comment on the draft policy after it is prepared ..." - The EPA will issue a separate notice to solicit comments on freshwater hypoxia or HAB events ..."
