### AGENDA CHANGE REQUESTS SUBJECT

<b>ACR'S (14)</b>		
C (5/1)	1	Modify groundfish possession and landing requirements to specify when groundfish bycatch levels are assessed on board a vessel. (5 AAC 28.070) – The Board found this ACR would provide an important management tool and met the conservation threshold.
N/A	2	Implement a management plan for an open-access weathervane scallop fishery in waters of Alaska. (5 AAC 38.0XX) – <i>No action was taken based on action under ACR 8</i> .
C (6/0)	3	Remove dip net size restrictions for the Yukon Area districts 1–3 commercial summer chum salmon fisheries. (5 AAC 05.362). – <i>Initial motion to accept the ACR carried at 6/0, and was reconfirmed under a motion to reconsider by 6/0.</i>
<b>F</b> (0/6)	4	Establish monofilament purse seines as a new legal gear for the Yukon Area districts 1–3 commercial summer chum salmon fisheries. (5 AAC 39.170 and 5 AAC 05.362) – <i>Initial motion to accept the ACR carried at 4/2, but failed under a motion to reconsider by 0/6. The Board found that while economic opportunities are needed in the Yukon area, the proposal did not address conservation concerns and could still be done through a Commissioner's permit.</i>
F (0/6)	5	Eliminate all other consumptive uses of the Sitka Sound herring stock in order to provide reasonable subsistence opportunity. (5 AAC 27.160, 5 AAC 27.170, and 5 AAC 27.195). The board found the ACR did not meet the threshold conservation criteria required to move forward as a proposal.
<b>F</b> (1/5)	6	Establish statewide regulation to allow use of dip net gear in place of commercial gillnet and seine gear for salmon stock conservation purposes. (5 AAC 39.2XX) – The Board found the ACR did not meet any of the threshold criteria required to move forward as a proposal.
<b>C</b> (6/0)	7	Define and allow use of a lead for commercial fish wheel gear. (5 AAC 05.333) - The Board found it was unforeseen that the use of leads in commercial fish wheel operations are not defined in regulation.
C	8	Implement a management plan for an open-access weathervane scallop fishery

	in waters of Alaska. (5 AAC 38.0XX) – The Board found that absent Board
	actions the fishery would be open to any participants which created a potential
	conservation concern.
9	Remove the exception allowing for a dead king salmon to be taken, but not
	retained, in the Yukon Area districts 1–3 dip net and beach seine commercial
	summer chum salmon fisheries. (5 AAC 05.362) – <i>The Board found it was</i>
	unforeseen that enforcement of this regulation would be difficult.
10	Remedy a navigational obstruction in Ugashik River set gillnet salmon fishery.
	(5 AAC 06.331) – Board found that current regulations allowed for an
	unforeseen navigational obstruction.
11	Define commercial salmon fishing boundaries for the Outer Port Heiden, Ilnik,
	and Three Hills sections in the Northern District of Area M using GPS
	coordinates. (5 AAC 09.200, 5 AAC 09.350, and 5 AAC 09.369) - Board
	found that the ACR did not meet the thresholds required to qualify as an ACR
	in that the impacts were not unintended or unforeseen.
12	Modify the time period the Nushagak River single hook regulation is in effect
	from year-round to May 1–July 31. (5 AAC 67.022) – The Board determined
	a provision passed to regulate sport fish activity appeared to have unintended
	impacts.
13	Modify Kuskokwim River salmon management plan for king salmon
	conservation. (5 AAC 01, 5 AAC 07, and 5 AAC 71) – The Board determined
	that while the region was experiencing several stocks of concern, the ADF&G
	had adequate fishery management tools and requested continued work with the
	local advisory committees and communities.
14	Modify the time period the Nushagak River single hook regulation is in effect
	from year-round to May 1–July 31. (5 AAC 67.022) – No action was taken
	based on action taken on ACR 12.

- 7. ACRs accepted for review in the 2013/14 meeting schedule were scheduled for the Statewide King and Tanner Crab meeting, Anchorage, March 17-21, 2014, with the exception of ACR 8 which will be heard at the Kodiak finfish meeting in Kodiak, January 7-11, 2014.
- 8. Board discussed and agreed that ethics disclosures were an appropriate action to take at the annual work session meeting.
- 9. Board discussed the Department's request to change the ACR deadline date from 45 to 60 days in regulations and scheduled the topic for the Chignik meeting, December 5-6, 2013. The action will be developed as a board generated proposal.
- 10. The Board agreed to take up several subjects with the Board of Game at the upcoming Joint Board meeting, October 12–16, 2013, including:
  - a. Developing Joint Board criteria for Board Generated Proposals.
  - b. Revising the proposal form.
  - c. Developing a preferred template for advisory committee minutes.
