- C/A 11 Close nonresident moose hunting in 22B, C, and D.

- C/A 8 Reduce seasons and bag limits for moose in 22A.
 RC 23, page 2 – Central: Aug. 15 – Sept. 25 Resident
 Strike “Antlered” for other portions

 C 7 Require meat-on-bone salvage for moose and caribou in entire Unit.

 C/A 4 Align brown bear seasons throughout Unit.
