The high cost of living in the village is also a great factor, another reason for the need of moose meat to supplement our diet.

We the Egepik Village Tribal Council formally request an extension of the subsistence resident moose hunt of unit 9E until February 15, 2009 for the community of Egepik and support with Ugashik Community residents to extend the Subsistence Moose Hunt time period. Although the hunting effort has been strong with the cold severe weather conditions, there have been only one successful moose hunt by an Egepik Village resident in December. The residents of Egepik Village have been solely depend upon moose meat as a regular part of their diet especially since they are no longer able to harvest caribou due to the low population of the Northern Peninsula Herd.

Another factor that is affecting our community is the high cost of living in the village along with many Alaskan villages in the region. Egegik is the highest in the region for Electricity at \$1.16 kilowate causing a hardship for all the residents in electricity, higher field & freight costs to ship in food to the community to feed their families.

Because of these factors we would like to see a 9E solely for subsistence moose limiting next full. It would also help to alleviate local people who are trying to feed their families for the winter having to compete with non residential sport hunters. There was one boat from local residents who harvested two moose and the rest of the community did not get any moose this past fall and having so many sports hunters played a factor in that low count unfortunately. While we support sports hunters coming to the area, at this time the moose population is down and people are negatively impacted by the downward economic trend we are going through. Therefore we need to reserve the moose hunt solely for subsistence to insure the community has mean to susmin them through the long winter months. Thank you for consideration of our request.
