

#### GAME MANAGEMENT UNIT 4

- Population ~13,000.
- Admiralty Is. (1700 sq mi.), Baranof Is. (1870 sq. mi.), Chichagof Is. (2220 sq. mi.) and 5,000 miles of coastline
- Healthcare, government, seafood processing, services, education and tourism remain the major forces in the economy.





### **BROWN BEAR**



- Population density in excess of 1 bear/sq. mi.
- To date, harvest has been under 4% of population (~140-200 yearly)
- Nonconsumptive uses very important
- Problems / DLPs
- U4BBMT adopted strategy 2000



#### Since 2000:


- Brown bear hunter harvest has averaged 145 bears/yr
- NR hunters averaged ~100 bears/yr
- R hunters averaged 46 bears/yr
- Average >725 permits issued/year
- DLP kills averaged 9 bears/yr






- •Winter of 2006-07 had record for snow depth. March 2007 snowfall cut the population from 45-80%
- •Doe closure for NE Chichagof area issued Nov 07, Oct 08, Sept 09, Sept 10.
- •NE Chichagof deer collaring project began in fall 2008


Except for NE Chichagof, and small portions of E Admiralty, W Chichagof, the bulk of Unit appears to have a rebounding population.





- Since December of 2006:
- conducted a yearly average of 800 miles of shoreline deer condition surveys Jan-April
- conducted 12-22 beach mortality surveys annually
- · captured/collared 27 deer in the Freshwater Bay complex NECH







Residents take the bulk of the harvest.

Department published a Goat ID booklet and quiz to help hunters tell the difference between nannies and billies.


Wounding loss also remains a concern.








- Populations stable and healthy

- Fur value in 2009 was \$80-90.




### MINK

Habitat alteration due to logging – amount and location of 2<sup>nd</sup> growth stands and their treatment


# Taser research project


Feasibility project with TASER, Inc. R&D to test effectiveness of ECDs on brown bears. Devices involve hand held (MX), self-contained 12 ga shotgun rounds (XREP), fixed-base remote (Shockwave) systems.







•Initial effort in Southeast Region was in August 2009 at the Yakutat landfill. Control group were radio-collared bears captured earlier in the year at the site. Work was videotaped and Taser, Inc. staff took back results to R&D to redesign hardware.










Sitka Management Area GMU 4

Salt Lake Bay and Mitchell Bay Closed Areas


Salt Lake Bay is 4.2 sq. miles.

"Closed to the taking of bears within 1/4 mile of lake."

Mitchell Bay is 24.7 sq. miles.

"Closed to the taking of brown bears within 660' of mean high tide."

Both of these areas were originally part of the Thayer Mountain Reserve closed in 1944 with modifications in 1984 and 1992.




Port Althorp Closed Area

### **Proposal 28**


- This proposal would modify department policy for setting allowable harvest of brown bear in Unit 4. Bears killed DLP would not count against the allowable harvest.
