Please see attached map showing yellow highlighted areas that are being requested to be closed to hunting. Arreas included are Margarete Creek and the drainages in Rudyerd Bay and Walker Cove. Rudyerd Bay is the area of Misty Fjords National Monument that sees the greatest number of visitors, more than 20,000 annually Spread over 30 Ketchikan businesses. Margaret Creek is permitted by the US Forest Service for le Ketchikan businesses to bring visitors for bear viewing tours. Only the yellow highlighted areas are being requested for bear hunting closures. Whitman Hatchery is also highlighted in yellow. Please review these areas closely & carefully for Size as stated in the Proposals. Their actual size may have been misrepresented to the Board by the dept of tish + Game!

(d) In any hunt requiring that nonresidents be personally accompanied by a registered guide or resident second-degree-kindred relative while hunting, pursuing, or taking big game, if a nonresident hunter chooses to be accompanied by a resident second-degree-kindred relative, the resident second-degree-kindred relative must have in possession a valid Alaska big game hunting license.

5 AAC 92.990. Definitions.

"personally accompany" means staying within close enough proximity to the person being accompanied to communicate by whisper or touch at the point where an attempt to take game is made.
