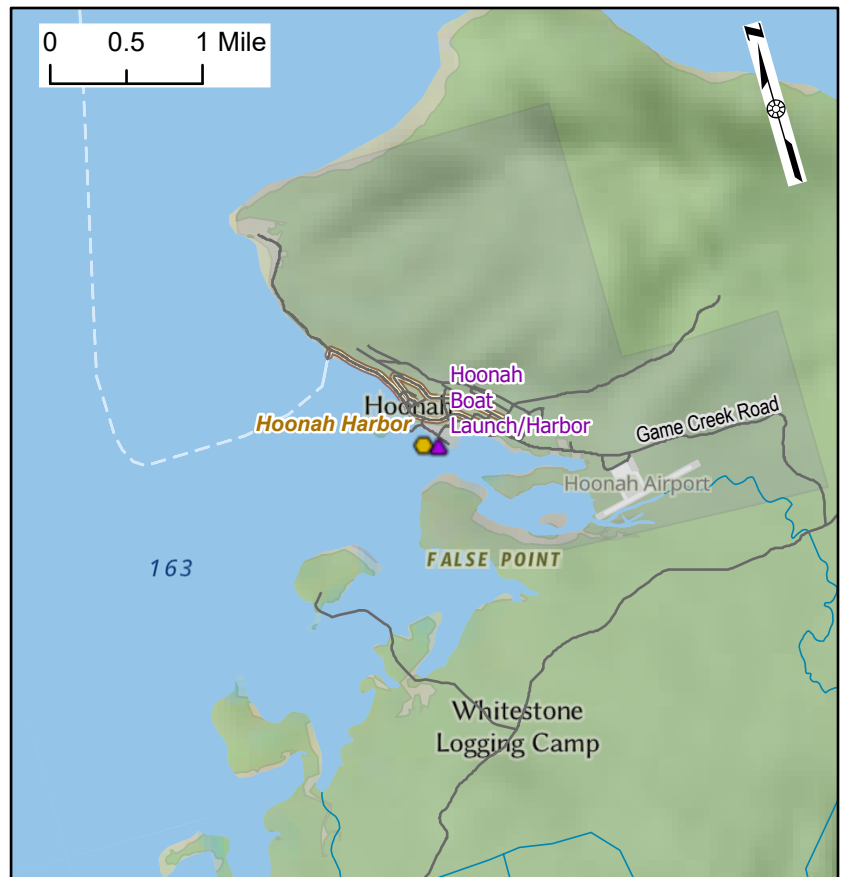


Juneau-Glacier Bay Area

Hoonah Harbor

Hoonah is located just inside Port Frederick off of Icy Strait. Cruise ships stop at Icy Strait Point (renovated cannery) that now offers many tours, shops, restaurants.

Capacity

There are two harbors in Hoonah, the Hoonah City Dock (outer harbor) and the George Hall Harbor facility (inner harbor). At the George Hall Harbor facility there are ~230 berths with a transient dock and new visitor dock to accommodate larger vessels. Annual and transient rates available. The Hoonah City dock (outer harbor) is used for loading and unloading vessels.

Getting There

Located on northeast Chichagof Island, it is 40 air miles west of Juneau and ~55 miles by boat from the Auke Bay harbor in Juneau.

Parking

Parking lots available.

Amenities

Fuel, showers, fresh water, laundry facilities, fish cleaning tables, dumpsters, oil disposal, haulout facilities, electricity, and walking distance to restaurants and hotels.
