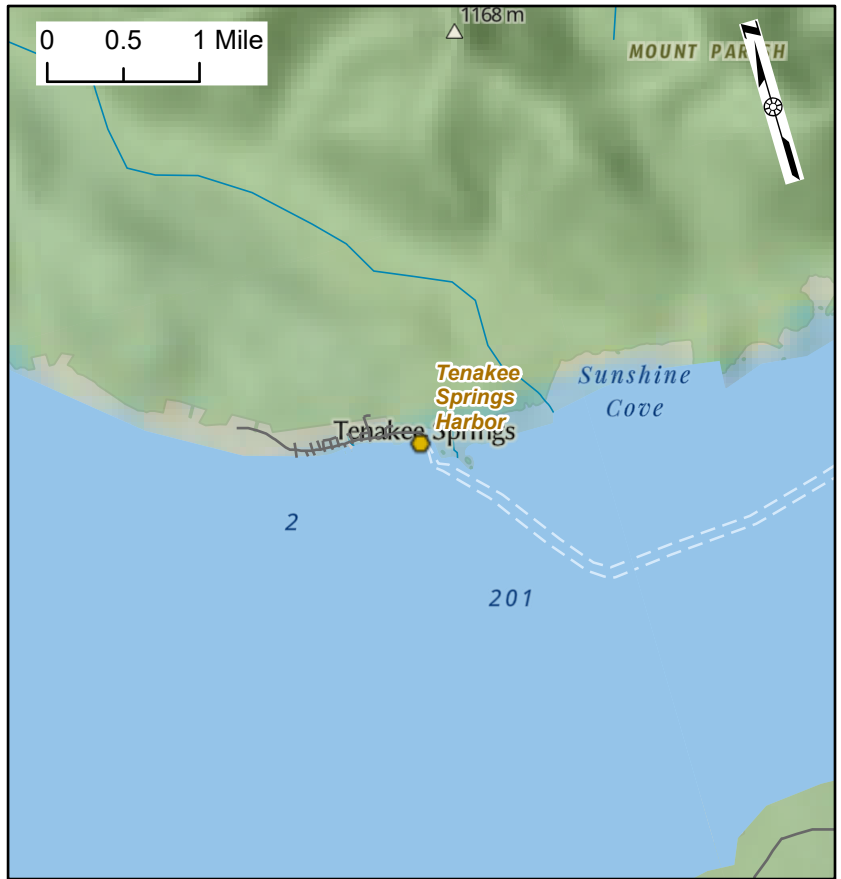


*Juneau-Glacier Bay Area*  
**Tenakee Springs Harbor**

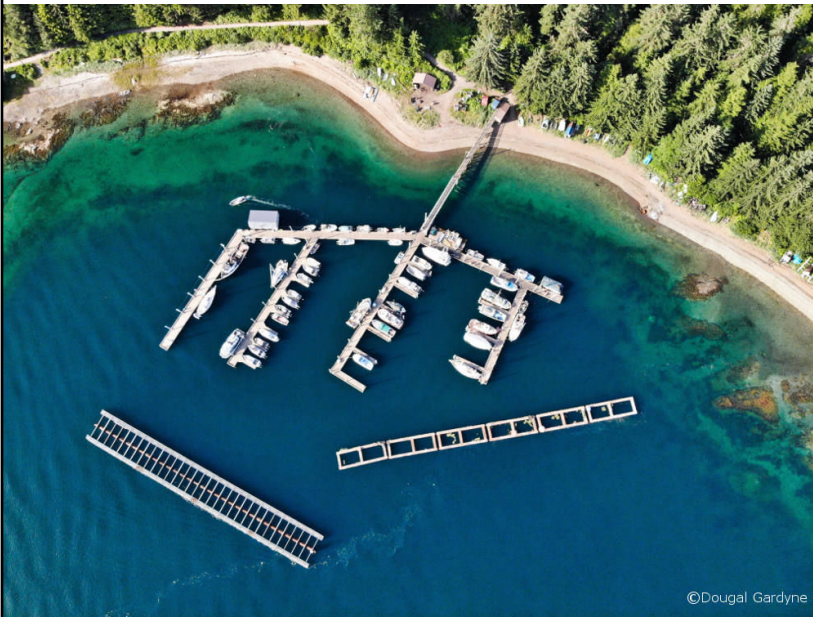
Tenakee Springs sits on the east side of Chichagof Island on Tenakee Inlet, 45 miles southwest of Juneau. The calm, nutrient rich waters of the 26-mile inlet attract bait fish and more than 750,000 salmon annually. People arrive here either by yacht or boat, on the ferry system, or (most frequently) by floatplane from Juneau. There are several transient moorage slips within Tenakee Harbor.
