



Shellfish



Shellfish are harvested in Petersburg/Wrangell area marine waters. Dungeness and shrimp are popular targets, particularly in summer. Crab and shrimp are caught in traps, pots, or ring nets baited with fish heads, tails, and viscera.

**SAFETY PRECAUTION**



The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation recommends no harvest of mussels, clams, scallops, and other filter-feeding bivalves for human consumption. Those shellfish can transmit Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning (PSP), a potentially lethal neurotoxin, to humans. Additional questions about this hazard should be directed to:
