	Coho Salmon	Late July through mid-October
	Pink Salmon	Mid-July through August
	Sockeye Salmon	Mid-July through mid-August
Russian River	Coho Salmon	Early August through end of September
	Sockeye Salmon	Early Run: Mid-June to mid-July Late Run: Mid-July to season closure mid-August
Kasilof River	Chinook Salmon	Late May through season closure late July
	Coho Salmon	Late July through September
	Pink Salmon	Mid-July through August
	Sockeye Salmon	June through August
	Steelhead Trout	Late-March through mid-May (catch-and-release only) Late August through mid-November (catch-and-release only)
Anchor River, Deep Creek, Ninilchik River	Chinook Salmon	Late May through mid-June
	Coho Salmon	Early August through mid-September
Anchor River	Steelhead Trout	Mid-August through early November (catch-and-release only)
Deep Creek Saltwater	Chinook Salmon	Early Run: Early May through late June Late Run: Late June through early August
Homer Spit	Chinook Salmon	Mid-May through early July
	Coho Salmon	Early Run: Mid-July through early August Late Run: Early August through mid-September
	Dolly Varden	Mid-May through mid-July
Halibut Cove	Chinook Salmon	Mid-May through early July
Clam Gulch, Deep Creek, Polly Creek	Razor Clam	All year, on minus-2 foot tides or lower * Check Emergency Orders prior to going. This fishery has been closed every year due to low abundance on the eastside beaches.

Please review the Southcentral Alaska Sport Fishing Regulations Summary booklet before you go fishing. All of these waters have regulations affecting bag and possession limits, tackle, areas open to fishing, and hours open to fishing. **Don't forget to check for Emergency Orders!** ADF&G may either close, restrict, open, or liberalize all or part of these fisheries at any given time.
