PORT MOLLER COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #4 **For Emergency Orders #4-FS-M-PM-4-21**

That portion of the Bear River Section located from the southern 1,000 yard regulatory marker at King Salmon River to a point on the Sandy River Bluffs at 160° 19.64' W. long. will remain closed to commercial salmon fishing until further notice as per previous Advisory Announcement. The remaining portion of the Bear River Section will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, June 23 until 6:00 p.m. Thursday, June 24.

Salmon fishery announcements will be broadcast on VHF channel 72 daily at 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. and may also be obtained from ADF&G in Port Moller at 375-2716.
