Sand Point Commercial Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #04
For Emergency Order #4-FS-M-SP-02-21

Due to the results of the July 5 test fishery of 91.6 immature salmon per set, the Shumagin Islands Section of the Southeastern District **WILL OPEN** to commercial salmon fishing by seine gear from 6:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 6 until 3:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 7, 2021.

Commercial salmon fishing by **set gillnet and seine gear** will be allowed for 33 hours from 6:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 6 until 3:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 7 in the following districts and sections:

Unimak District
Southwestern District
South Central District
Shumagin Islands Section of the Southeastern District

Commercial salmon fishing by **drift gillnet gear** will be allowed for 33 hours from 6:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 6 until 3:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 7 in the following districts and sections:

Unimak District
Ikatan Bay Section of the Southwestern District

All closed waters in the above locations will be as described in the regulation book or as adjusted by emergency order.
