The Nelson Lagoon Section will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 11:59 p.m. Saturday, July 10 until 11:59 p.m. Thursday, July 15.

The Port Moller Bight, Bear River, Three Hills and Ilnik Sections will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Saturday, July 10 until 6:00 p.m. Monday, July 12.

The stream terminus at the ocean shoreline at Bear River will open to commercial salmon fishing at noon Saturday, July 10 until 6:00 p.m. Monday, July 12. All other closed waters are as described in regulation.
