PORT MOLLER COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #21 For Emergency Orders #4-FS-M-PM-21-21

The Port Moller Bight, Bear River, Three Hills and Ilnik Sections will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Monday, July 12 until 6:00 p.m. Thursday, July 15.

The stream terminus at the ocean shoreline at Bear River will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Monday, July 12 until 6:00 p.m. Thursday, July 15. All other closed waters are as described in regulation.

Statistical charts and harvest strategies are available at the Sand Point, Cold Bay, and Port Moller Fish and Game offices. Commercial salmon fishing regulations, commercial harvest, escapement, and news releases can be found on the ADF&G website at:

Salmon fishery announcements will be broadcast on VHF channel 72 daily at 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. and may also be obtained from ADF&G in Port Moller at 375-2716.
