Sand Point Commercial Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #24 For Emergency Order #4-FS-M-SP-22-21

Commercial salmon fishing by **set gillnet and seine gear** will be allowed in the Beaver Bay, Balboa Bay, Southwest Stepovak, East Stepovak, and Northwest Stepovak Sections of the Southeastern District for 59 hours from 9:00 a.m. Friday, September 10 until 8:00 p.m. Sunday, September 12. The Stepovak Flats Section will remain closed.

All closed waters in the above locations will be as described in the regulation book or as adjusted by emergency order.

As a reminder, Fishermen are encouraged to ensure they have a secure market before harvesting salmon.
