Prince William Sound Salmon Fishery Announcement #53

SEINE FISHERIES: Seine fisheries will be closed to evaluate fisheries performance data. PWSAC cost recovery fishing is ongoing and they collected approximately 84% of the assigned pink salmon revenue goal. Industry sampling of fish harvested from AFK and CCH on August 12 was 42% and 28% female, respectively. On the ground sampling of fish harvested from WNH on August 13 was 48% female. Broodstock collection is occurring at both AFK and WNH.

Future fishing opportunities targeting PWSAC pink salmon are dependent on run entry, cost recovery progress, and broodstock collection. To minimize the risk of negatively impacting broodstock collection, if and when there is an opener, it may be short in duration (< 12 hours) with limited area. The Department will announce daily through Wednesday, to provide the fleet with up-to-date information pertaining to a potential opener targeting surplus PWSAC fish.

Copies of the updated regulation booklet, *2022-2024 Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations for Prince William Sound*, are not yet available in the Cordova ADFG office. ALL buyers purchasing fish in the PWS Management Area are required to complete a Processor Registration Form. Contact the Cordova office for any questions regarding registration.

The next scheduled seine fisheries announcement is anticipated to be at 2:00 pm on Monday, August 15. The next scheduled gillnet fisheries announcement is anticipated to be at 2:00 pm on Wednesday, August 17.

Permit holders are advised that unscheduled announcements based on current escapement data may occur at anytime inseason either establishing an additional period or extending an open period.

Unless otherwise specified, all openings are clock openings based on Alaska Daylight Time, which is based on Coordinated Universal Time and may be obtained by calling 303-499-7111.

The department encourages commercial permit holders to renew their licenses early and to check their CFEC vessel registration stickers to make sure they are current.

The department also encourages permit holders to report observed violations to Wildlife Safeguard at 800-478-3377. Reports are anonymous and cash rewards may be paid for successful prosecution of violations.
