ANITA BAY TERMINAL HARVEST AREA FISHERIES ANNOUNCEMENT

Southern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (SSRAA) is forecasting total runs of 275,000 summer chum, 7,700 Chinook, and 10,100 coho salmon to the Anita Bay release site in 2023. It is anticipated that 112,300 summer chum, 6,200 Chinook, and 4,800 coho salmon will be available for harvest in the Anita Bay Terminal Harvest Area (THA).

Anita Bay THA is scheduled to close to common property commercial salmon fishing at 11:59 p.m., Saturday, July 15. SSRAA is currently planning to conduct cost recovery efforts from Sunday, July 16 through Saturday, August 12. If cost recovery objectives are met before August 12, common property fishing could be reopened. When cost recovery efforts cease in August, the area will be open to rotational harvest beginning with purse seine, through Thursday, August 31. Any openings prior to September 1 will be announced by a subsequent advisory announcement.

The Anita Bay THA will be open continuously to harvest salmon with troll gear from 5:00 a.m., Thursday, June 1, through 11:59 p.m., Saturday, July 15, and from 12:01 a.m., Sunday, August 13, through 12:00 noon, Friday, November 10. The Anita Bay THA will be open to harvest salmon with drift gillnet and purse seine gear concurrently from 5:00 a.m., Thursday, June 1, through 12:00 noon, Monday, June 12, then on a rotational basis from 12:00 noon, Tuesday, June 13, through 12:00 noon, Friday, July 14, and again 12:00 noon, Sunday, August 13, through 12:00 noon, Thursday, August 31, then concurrently from 12:01 a.m., Friday, September 1, through 12:00 noon, Friday, November 10. The Anita Bay THA will close for the season at 12:00 noon, Friday, November 10, 2023.

Anita Bay THA consists of those waters of Anita Bay south and west of a line from the tip of Anita Point at 56°13.68′ N lat, 132°22.48′ W long to a point on the northern shore at 56°14.26′ N lat, 132°23.93′ W long.

Waters closed to commercial salmon fishing within the THA include:

- (1) from 5:00 a.m., Thursday, June 1, through 12:00 noon, Friday, June 16, the waters of the Anita Bay THA north and east of a line from 56°12.90′ N lat, 132°24.51′ W long to 56°12.75′ N lat, 132°23.50′ W long will be closed to the harvest of salmon with commercial seine and drift gillnet gear;
- (2) from Thursday, June 15, through Sunday, June 25, the waters of the Anita Bay THA west of 132°26.19′ W long will be closed to the harvest of salmon;
- (3) from Monday, June 26, through Saturday, July 1, the waters of the Anita Bay THA west of 132°26.98′ W long will be closed to the harvest of salmon;
- (4) and from Sunday, July 2, through Thursday, July 6, the waters of the Anita Bay THA west of 132°28.00′ W long will be closed to the harvest of salmon.

From 12:01 a.m., Thursday, June 15, through 11:59 p.m., Monday, July 10, waters within 0.25 nautical mile of the northern shoreline of Anita Bay west of a line from $56^{\circ}12.33'$ N lat, $132^{\circ}26.19'$ W long to $56^{\circ}12.06'$ N lat, $132^{\circ}26.19'$ W long and east of a line from $56^{\circ}11.96'$ N lat, $132^{\circ}29.57'$ W long to $56^{\circ}11.73'$ N lat, $132^{\circ}29.36'$ W long will be open.

Beginning Tuesday, June 13, the following rotation schedules will be in effect through Friday, July 14, unless changed by a subsequent announcement.

<u>Chinook Salmon Landing Restrictions for Troll Gear</u>: Chinook salmon harvested within the Anita Bay THA that are 28 inches or greater in length may be retained and sold.

<u>Chinook Salmon Landing Restrictions for Purse Seine Gear</u>: All Chinook salmon harvested within the Anita Bay THA may be retained and sold from 5:00 a.m., Thursday, June 1, through 12:00 noon, Tuesday, July 4.
