


Figure 1.- Chenik Lagoon, west of 154° 08.33' W. longitude is closed.

Subdistrict, and the Kirschner Lake special harvest area (SHA). Fishing periods (excluding the Chenik Subdistrict) are 7-days per week, 24-hours per day. An aerial survey of the Chenik lagoon on Saturday, July 8 documented a minimum of 5,000 sockeye salmon in the Chenik lagoon. Video monitoring of salmon passage into Chenik Lake began on June 15. To date, 131 sockeye salmon have been documented entering Chenik Lake. Escapement monitoring into Chenik Lake is ongoing in real-time. Fishing opportunity may be adjusted on short notice based on this.

The next scheduled commercial salmon fisheries announcement is anticipated to be on Friday, July 14.
