# KODIAK SUBSISTENCE SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #05 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-Sub-05-23

Through July 23, 2,233 sockeye salmon have been counted through the Pasagshak River weir. Historically by this date, approximately fifty six percent of the sockeye salmon escapement has passed the weir. It is expected that the Pasagshak sockeye escapement goal of 3,000 will be achieved.

The following area will **open** to subsistence salmon fishing at **12:01 a.m. Thursday**, **July 27** until further notice:

In Pasagshak Bay to those waters northeast of a line from a point at  $57^{\circ}$  26.04' N lat.  $152^{\circ}$  31.13' W long. to a point at  $57^{\circ}$  25.44' N lat.  $152^{\circ}$  29.39' W long.

### As previously announced:

Until 11:59 p.m. Sunday, December 31, 2023, Chinook salmon in the Karluk River drainage, including the Karluk River lagoon, may not be retained in the subsistence fishery.

#### Closed Water Adjustments

**Until further notice**, closed waters are **reduced** for subsistence fishing in the following locations:

- At Saltery Creek (stream #259-415) to the stream terminus; and,
- At Ouzinkie Harbor to the stream terminus of stream #259-396.

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game, under the direction of the Alaska Board of Fisheries, manages sport, commercial, personal use, and state subsistence harvest on all lands and waters throughout Alaska.
