## SOUTHEAST ALASKA SALMON PURSE SEINE FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

### District 1

The following areas will be open to purse seining from 6:00 a.m., Thursday, August 24, to 9:00 p.m., Friday, August 25, 2023:

Section 1-C: will be open south of a line from Fox Point at 55°15.60′ N lat, 131°03.88′ W long to a point south of Roe Point at 55°14.50′ N lat, 131°00.56′ W long.

Section 1-F: will be open south and east of a line from California Head at 55°19.57′ N lat, 131°29.07′ W long to Spire Island Reef Light at 55°16.08′ N lat, 131°29.98′ W long to the southernmost tip of Gravina Point at 55°17.12′ N lat, 131°37.19′ W long to a point on the western shore of Gravina Island at 55°20.87′ N lat, 131°51.94′ W long (located on the westernmost tip of an unnamed island immediately south of Grant Cove) then due west to the District 2 boundary with the following restrictions:

<u>Boca de Quadra</u>: will be closed east of a line from Quadra Point at 55°05.15′ N lat, 130°59.10′ W long to Kah Shakes Point at 55°04.26′ N lat, 130°58.80′ W long;

Section 14-B: will be open south of the latitude of Crist Point at 58°10.27′ N lat.

Section 14-C: will be open within 2.0 nmi of the Chichagof Island shoreline.

<u>Chinook Salmon Landing Restrictions</u>: All Chinook salmon harvested in the Deep Inlet Terminal Harvest Area must be retained and may be sold. For all other fishing areas, Chinook salmon 28 inches or greater in length may NOT be retained and Chinook salmon less than 28 inches may be retained but not sold.

When under nonretention of Chinook salmon 28 inches or larger, purse seine fishermen are encouraged to quickly release Chinook salmon in a manner that minimizes mortality. If Chinook salmon greater than 28 inches (large) are retained, the fisherman is in violation and may be issued a citation. Retained large Chinook salmon will be donated, and the fisherman may be subject to the cost associated with processing the fish for donation. On the fish ticket, the number and weight of the fish must be recorded and the disposition code "86-Donated" must be used.

Fishermen, tenders, and processors are reminded that all salmon, including steelhead, commercially harvested but retained for personal use and not sold, must be reported on fish tickets at the time of delivery.

The next seine announcement will be **Saturday**, **August 26**, unless all remaining processors indicate they are done buying pink salmon for the year, then the next seine announcement will be **Monday**, **August 28**, to announce the closure of the purse seine pink salmon fishery, potential fall chum salmon opportunities, and estimated harvests for the season.
