**2023/24 SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL SEA CUCUMBER FISHERY
ANNOUNCEMENT**

The following areas will be open with a 2,500-pound area specific trip limit from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 18, Monday, February 19, and Tuesday, February 20, 2024:

District 1:

Boca de Quadra (Subdistrict 101-30);

District 13:

Baranof Island Shoreline, Necker and Rakof Islands, West Crawfish Inlet, and Crawfish Inlet (Subdistricts 113-31, 32, and 33);

Sitka Sound (Subdistricts 113-38 and 41).

There is currently limited interest in purchasing sea cucumbers in the region. The remaining guideline harvest levels (GHLs) from South Mitkof and North Zarembo Islands (Subdistrict 108-30), Northern Chatham Strait (Subdistricts 112-16, 17, 63, and 65), and Excursion Inlet and Homeshore (Subdistricts 114-25-002 and 114-80) will be available until the season closes by regulation on March 31, 2024. The department will consider reopening these areas if there is expressed interest. Interested divers and processors should contact Area Management staff with plans prior to 12:00 noon on Thursday for a potential fishery the following week.

Fishers and processors are reminded that an accurate fish ticket is required at the time of delivery. A fish ticket must be filled out according to 5 AAC 39.130(c). Fishers must verify at the time of landing with the tender or processor that all information is accurate before signing the fish ticket, including statistical area, pounds of sea cucumbers harvested, and any overages.

For a description of the above areas, please refer to the Southeast Alaska commercial sea cucumber fishery announcement dated August 31, 2023, announcing the open areas and their GHLs. The next advisory announcement following this opening will be available on **Thursday, February 22, 2024**.

The Emergency Order corresponding to this announcement is EO 1M1224.

State offices will be closed Monday, February 19, 2024, for Presidents' Day.
