GUNNUK CREEK TERMINAL HARVEST AREA TROLL FISHERY

The **Gunnuk Creek Terminal Harvest Area (THA)** commercial salmon troll fishery will open for the harvest of Chinook, coho, chum, sockeye, and pink salmon from 12:01 a.m., Sunday, June 1, through 11:59 p.m., Monday, June 30, 2025, unless closed by emergency order.

The Gunnuk Creek THA (**statistical area 109-40**) consists of the waters of Keku Strait enclosed by a line from a point northwest of Kake at 56°58.92' N lat, 133°57.48' W long to the southernmost tip of the southern Mosquito Island at 56°58.22' N lat, 133°58.85' W long to the northwest tip of Hamilton Island at 56°56.45' N lat, 133°55.66' W long to Wooten's Dock at 56°57.55' N lat, 133°54.78' W long.

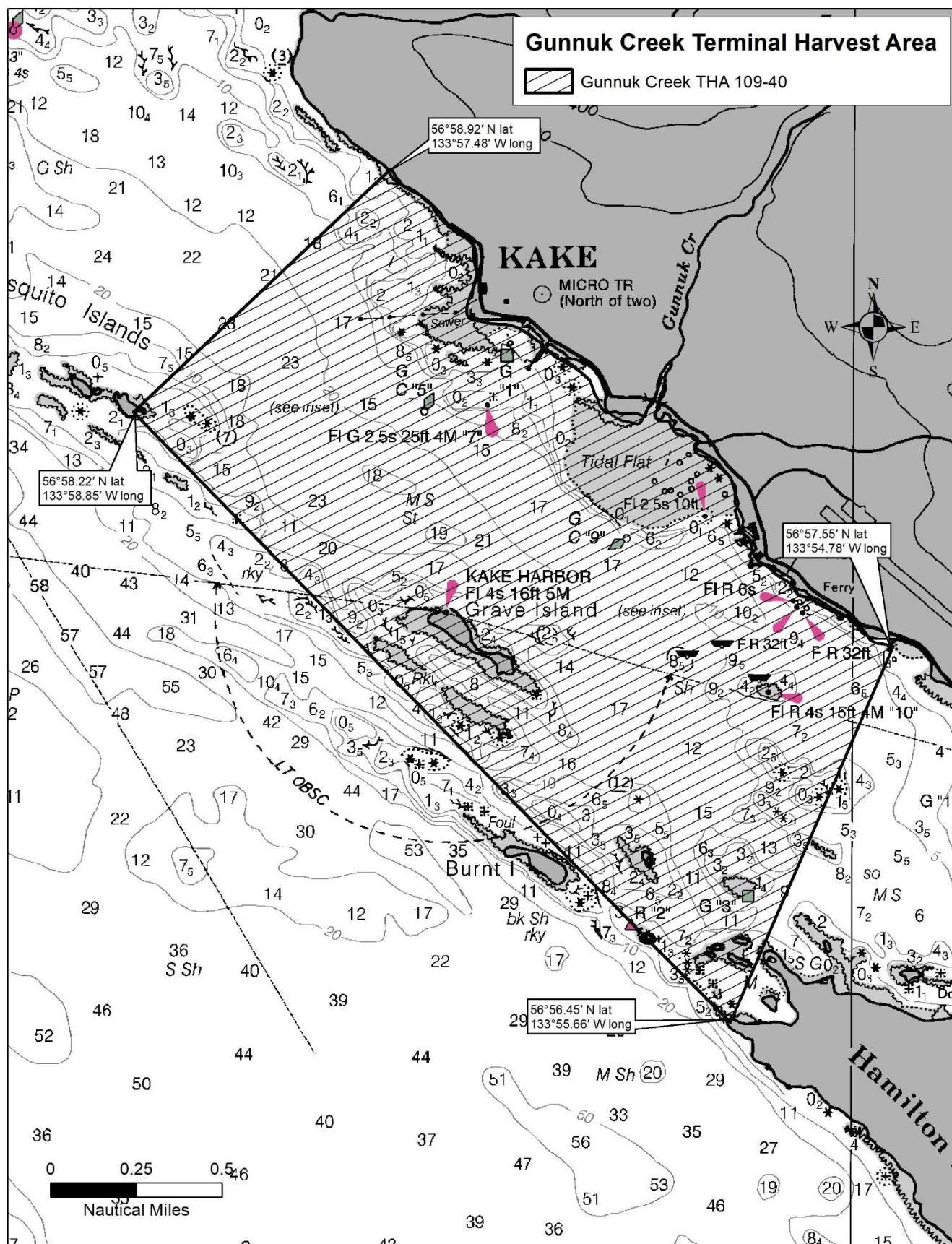


Figure 1.—Gunnuk Creek Terminal Harvest Area.
