## Time: 9:00 a.m. Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement #18 Emergency Order 18

This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak District. The time is 9:00 a.m. and the date is Saturday, June 28.

On June 27, the Naknek River escapement was 41,000 sockeye for a total of 138,000. The Kvichak River escapement on was 6,000 sockeye for a total of 27,000. The Kvichak inriver estimate is 30,000. Harvest on June 27 was an estimated 170,000 for a total of 480,000 fish.

The Naknek Section will open to drift gillnet gear for a 6-hour period from 3:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. Saturday, June 28 and again for an 8-hour period from 4:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon Sunday, June 29. The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to set gillnet gear for a 21-hour period from 3:00 p.m. Saturday, June 28 until 12:00 noon Sunday, June 29.

Fishermen in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand by at 9:00 a.m. Sunday, June 29.
