Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement #22 Emergency Order 24

This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak District. The time is 9:00 a.m. and the date is Monday, June 30.

The Naknek River escapement on June 29 was 34,000 sockeye and the midnight to 6:00 a.m. count this morning was 65,000 for a total of 260,000. The Kvichak River escapement on June 29 was 6,000 sockeye and the midnight to 6:00 a.m. count this morning was 14,000 for a total of 51,000. The Kvichak inriver estimate is 500,000. The harvest on June 29 was an estimated 400,000 for a total of 1.3 million fish. There are 213 vessels registered to fish in the district and there will be 235 in 48 hours.

The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to drift gillnet gear for a 6.5-hour period from 5:00 p.m. until 11:30 p.m. Monday, June 30 and again for an 8-hour period from 5:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 1. The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to set gillnet gear for a 20-hour period from 5:00 p.m. Monday, June 30 until 1:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 1.

Fishermen in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand by at 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 1 for the next possible announcement.
